BBE And when he came, the Jews who had come down from Jerusalem came round him, and made all sorts of serious statements against him, which were not supported by the facts.

【ASV】 And when he was come, the Jews that had come down from Jerusalem stood round about him, bringing against him many and grievous charges which they could not prove;

KHJV But Festus, willing to do the Jews a pleasure, answered Paul, and said, Wilt thou go up to Jerusalem, and there be judged of these things before me?

【NIV】 Festus, wishing to do the Jews a favor, said to Paul, "Are you willing to go up to Jerusalem and stand trial before me there on these charges?"

【牧灵版】保禄回答说:"我现在站在西泽的法庭上受审,这是我该受审的地方。你很清楚,我根本 不曾冒犯犹太人。

KIV For if I be an offender, or have committed any thing worthy of death, I refuse not to die: but if there be none of these things whereof these accuse me, no man may deliver me unto them. I appeal unto Caesar.

INIV If, however, I am guilty of doing anything deserving death, I do not refuse to die. But if the charges brought against me by these Jews are not true, no one has the right to hand me over to them. I appeal to Caesar!"

BBE If, then, I am a wrongdoer and there is a cause of death in me, I am ready for death: if it is not as they say against me, no man may give me up to them. Let my cause come before Caesar.

[ASV] If then I am a wrong-doer, and have committed anything worthy of death, I refuse not to die; but if none of those things is true whereof these accuse me, no man can give me up unto them. I appeal unto Caesar.

【现代本】在那里住了几天之后,非斯都把保罗的事告诉亚基帕王,说: "这里有一个人,是腓力斯 留下的囚犯。

【当代版】 他们住了几天后,非斯都向亚基帕提到保罗的案件说:"我这里有一个囚犯,是前任总督 腓利斯拘留到现去的。

【现代本】前次我上耶路撒冷,那边的犹太祭司长和长老控告他,要求我定他的罪。

【当代版】 上次我去耶路撒冷的时候,犹太祭司长和领袖们向我投诉,要求我把他定罪。

KJV About whom, when I was at Jerusalem, the chief priests and the elders of the Jews informed me, desiring to have judgment against him.

[NIV] When I went to Jerusalem, the chief priests and elders of the Jews brought charges against him and asked that he be condemned.

BBE Against whom the chief priests and the rulers of the Jews made a statement when I was at Jerusalem, requesting me to give a decision against him.

【ASV】 about whom, when I was at Jerusalem, the chief priests and the elders of the Jews informed me, asking for sentence against him.

KHIV To whom I answered, It is not the manner of the Romans to deliver any man to die, before that he which is accused have the accusers face to face, and have licence to answer for himself concerning the crime laid against him.

[NIV] I told them that it is not the Roman custom to hand over any man before he has faced his accusers and has had an opportunity to defend himself against their charges.

TBBE To whom I gave answer that it is not the Roman way to give a man up, till he has been face to face with those who are attacking him, and has had a chance to give an answer to the statements made against him.

【ASV】 To whom I answered, that it is not the custom of the Romans to give up any man, before that the accused have the accusers face to face, and have had opportunity to make his defense concerning the matter laid against him.
