【和修订】末了,弟兄们,我们靠着主耶稣求你们,劝你们,既然你们领受了我们的教导,知道该怎 样行事为人,讨神的喜悦,其实你们也正这样行,我劝你们要更加努力。

【新译本】此外,弟兄们,我们在主耶稣里求你们,劝你们,你们既然接受了我们的教训,知道应该 怎样行事为人,并且怎样讨 神喜悦,就要照你们现在所行的更进一步。

【吕振中】末了,弟兄们,我们在主耶稣里求你们,劝你们——你们既从我们领受了主的话,知道该 怎样行、让神喜欢,你们也真地这样行——我就劝你们要更加力行。
